Major Responsibilities

Nursing/Medical Care:

- 1. Perform limited obstetrical ultrasounds training will be provided if needed
- 2. Act as Client Advocate when needed
- 3. Perform pregnancy test, Woman's Right to Know education
- 4. Provide nursing/medical care, assessing client needs and making judgements which reflect safe nursing practices as pertains to pregnancy resource centers
- 5. Provide education for client and family to develop an understanding of their health conditions related to pregnancy
- 6. Handle medical questions from callers and clients
- 7. See that medical equipment is functioning properly

Public Relations:

- 1. Represent Gateway Women's Care in the community when called upon
- 2. Attend medical conferences offering professional training and information pertinent to Gateway's practices

Personal Development:

- 1. Maintain professional license and required CEUs
- 2. Increase knowledge of management, obstetrical and gynecological care and women's health issues.
- 3. Maintain a working knowledge of nursing methods, principles and practices in relation to the prevention and treatment of diseases, and safety and infection control.
